VILLAGE CLEANUP DAY

The Village clean up day has been scheduled for April 21, from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. Trotter Service will take old oil, filters, and batteries.

Tires without rims can also be left at Trotter Service for a small fee. Ravenna Sanitation will be located between the Red Dawg and the Pleasanton Fire Hall. He will be accepting old furniture, old mattresses, and other trash items. He will only accept dry paint. The Village will have a trailer there to take old refrigerators,

Dog Licensing

Dog Licenses are due May 1. The fee is \$5.25 for each male dog or spay female dog and \$6.25 for each non-spay female dog. **A copy of their current rabies vaccination is also needed to license your pet.** Licensing helps the Village employees find the pets home if found at large. It also reassures residents and other pet owners that dogs at large have been vaccinated. Article 3 Section 2-301-405 in the Village Municipal Code book concerns Dogs in the village and can be viewed at the office or on our website at www.pleasantonne.com

VILLAGE RECYCLE BINS AND DUMPSTER

A reminder on the use of the dumpster and recycle bin the Village provides. There is a limitation on what the Village is allowed to take to the City of Kearney recycle plant.

ACCEPTABLE items are: Cardboard, (please cut down the boxes), paper, aluminum cans, and plastic bottles.

UNACCEPTABLE items are: Styrofoam, household trash, car parts, tv's and electronics.

GOOD WILL accepts electronics at no charge.

COMPUTER HARDWARE will take tv's and electronics for a charge of .45 a lb.

The dumpster that is located by the Village Maintenance shop is available if you have extra household trash. **NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL PLEASE!**
